Ps. 8:9, “LORD, our Lord, how majestic is Your name in all the earth!”

The Hebrew word for *majestic* is **addir** which means *magnificent, mighty, powerful and above all*. There are sometimes that I am overwhelmed by just the thought of my Heavenly Father. When you think of all His magnificent qualities, it is too much to truly comprehend. He Who spoke **everything** into being. He set the ends of the universe. He knows every star by name. He knows every hair on your head. He knows every particle of sand on the sea shores. The bottom line is God knows everything.

And, because of this, the Psalmist is declaring that the name of the LORD is mighty, powerful and above all. It is no wonder that one of God’s commands is to not use the name of the LORD in vain. In due time their foot will slip; their day of disaster is near and their doom rushes upon them.”**

We cannot take this lightly. Our God deserves all praise and glory and honor. Let’s remember how holy and awesome He is.
