Isa. 25:1, “Lord, you are my God; I will exalt You and praise Your name, for in perfect faithfulness You have done wonderful things, things planned long ago.”

I love this phrase from the prophet Isaiah: *for in perfect faithfulness You have done wonderful things*. This is a beautiful picture of our LORD God. He is perfect in every way. His ways are perfect. His love is perfect. His motives are perfect. And, Isaiah points out that His faithfulness is perfect. Wouldn't it be awesome if we lived in a world where everyone was faithful all the time? If someone said that they would do something, you'd never have to worry about them doing it. And yet we are a flawed people, prone to do what we want out of selfish desires.

But there is a blessed assurance we have with our LORD. He is faithful in every situation because that is Who He is. He is Faithful God. This characteristic of God is found in His promise in **Jer. 29:11-12** " *For I know the plans I have for you,” declares the Lord, “plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future. Then you will call on Me and come and pray to Me, and I will listen to you. You will seek Me and find Me when you seek Me with all your heart.*”

And again we read in **2 Cor. 1:20**, “*For no matter how many promises God has made, they are “Yes” in Christ. And so through Him the “Amen” is spoken by us to the glory of God.*”

Everything that our LORD has done, He already planned it and now they are coming to fruition. Our God is perfectly faithful!
