Ps. 18:30, "As for God, His way is perfect: The Lord's word is <u>flawless</u>; He shields all who take refuge in Him."

Have you noticed how many books have been written claiming to be the authority on certain subjects? Each of these books seem to be the final word about the certain topic. Of course, in a couple of years, they are shown to not know exactly what they were purporting to be experts about.

God's word is flawless. Flawless is the highest designation of a diamond and it is also the highest praise for His word. Everything in God's word is perfect. In fact, God admonished His people in Dt. 4:2, "Do not add to what I command you and do not subtract from it, but keep the commands of the LORD your God that I give you." And again in Rev. 22:18-19, "I warn everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this scroll: If anyone adds anything to them, God will add to that person the plagues described in this scroll. And if anyone takes words away from this scroll of prophecy, God will take away from that person any share in the tree of life in the Holy City, which are described in this scroll."

God's way is perfect. His word is infallible and is always the source we can go to when we need direction, correction or encouragement. And, David then states that for those who know and trust in God's word, He becomes a shield to all who take refuge in Him. We can be sure that when God says something in His word, it will come to pass. His ways are perfect. His words are perfect because He is perfect.

Dear LORD, thank You that we can rely completely in Your Word. You speak and we should listen and obey. Help us to not take Your Word for granted, but instead, help us to build upon the foundation of Your great Word. In Jesus Name, Amen
