Jer. 23:6 *“In His days Judah will be saved and Israel will live in safety. This is the name by which He will be called: The LORD Our Righteous Savior.”* (NIV)

The LORD our Righteous Savior: Jehovah Tsidkenu. The LORD is perfect in all of His ways. He is and will always be. When you think of the word righteous, you immediately are drawn to the fact that He is absolutely right all of the time.
