Let the sea and everything in it shout His praise! Let the earth and all living things join in. Let the rivers clap their hands in glee! Let the hills sing out their songs of joy before the LORD, for He is coming to judge the earth. He will judge the world with justice, and the nations with fairness.” (NIV)
