Ps. 40:3, "He put a new song in my mouth, a hymn of praise to our God. Many will see and fear the LORD and put their trust in Him."

The Hebrew word for *put a new song* is **tehillah** which means *a praise that God inhabits*. When we praise the LORD, He literally indwells and abides in us. Praise is a powerful movement that actually allows God to be exalted in our spirit and draws us closer into His presence. **Ps. 22:3**, *"But You are holy, O You that inhabits the praise of His people."*

Now this is not some magical chant or summons that we can orchestrate God to have to fulfill our wishes; not at all! But it is a call for us to desire the presence and empowerment of the Holy Spirit as we worship our LORD. I love the song written by **Elliott Bannister** and **Michael Vincent Hudso**n –
