## Jer. 32:27, "I AM the LORD, the God of all mankind. Is there anything too <u>hard</u> for Me?"

The Hebrew word for *hard* is **yip pa le** which means *extremely difficult, extraordinarily hard or impossible*. When you think of the LORD our God, you are probably satisfied with the fact that He is creator of all there is. Think of that spectrum for just a little while. He made air, sky, space, planets, stars, galaxies, electrons, protons, neutrons, light, animals, plants, rocks, dirt, and everything else that exists. He said: "Who is this that obscures My plans with words without knowledge? Brace yourself like a man; I will question you, and you shall answer Me. "Where were you when I laid the earth's foundation? Tell Me, if you understand. Who marked off its dimensions? Surely you know! Who stretched a measuring line across it? On what were its footings set, or who laid its cornerstone—while the morning stars sang together and all the angels shouted for joy?" Our God is an awesome God Who holds all power in His hands. NOTHING is too HARD for HIM!
