Ps. 34:4, "I sought the LORD, and He answered me; He delivered me from all my fears."

What a wonderful picture for today. I am reminded of the fact that my Father is always available. I never have to wonder if He will hear me when I call. Earlier in **Ps. 27:7** David cries out to the LORD saying; "Hear my voice when I call, LORD; be merciful to me and answer me."

It was a regular practice of David, to call out to the LORD. How about for you? Do you call out to Him consistently? He is always available. **Jer. 33:3** reminds us of this: 'Call to Me and I will answer you and tell you great and unsearchable things you do not know.' Having grown up with my Grand-dad as my father figure, I would always go to him for advice and counsel. He was a very wise man who didn't speak very much. But, when he did, it was a word I needed to hear. He once told me that is I was confused about something and didn't know what to do, to pray about it and ask the LORD to give me the answer. To this day, I try to remember this great bit of wisdom. James 1:5 says: "If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, Who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you."

Let's not try to "make it through this day" alone. We have a Heavenly Father that is desiring to lead us. He is our light in the darkness. He is the wisdom beyond all wisdom. He knows everything that we need. He will be there for you. Call unto Him. He will answer. You will never get a busy signal or an answering machine. He will listen to you and He will answer you. And, He will deliver you from all of your fears.

Dear LORD, help us to seek You rather than the answers that this world tries to give. They are faulty at the core. They cannot be trusted; but You can! Help us to put our total trust in You for every need we have. We call on You today. In Jesus Name, Amen.
