Ps. 34:9, "Fear the LORD, you His holy people, for those who fear Him lack nothing."

The Hebrew word for *fear* is **yeru** which means *to see as awesome, to revere, stand in awe and show reverence*. It is amazing to me how many people lack a reverence for Who the LORD is. His name is used in vain. His reputation is tarnished. His faithfulness is questioned. His existence is even doubted.

To see Him like He really is, is to see Him as awesome, loving, all-powerful, holy, absolutely in control and perfect in every way. There has never been, nor will there ever be, anyone like Him. He holds all power in His hands. He set the boundaries of the universe. He created all things that exist and He holds all things together. Col. 1:16-17, "For in Him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things have been created through Him and for Him. He is before all things, and in Him all things hold together."

I love how David states that those who fear Him, see Him like He really is, will lack nothing. Why? Because the LORD takes care of them. He will always provide. He will always protect. He will always comfort. He will always love. He will always be in control. He is my rock and my fortress. He is my all in all. He is the love that never fails. He is my portion forever. He is my Father. He is my Redeemer. He is my salvation. If I have the LORD, I have need of nothing else!

Dear LORD, You are Holy and Righteous. You deserve all of our praise. Help us to see You like You really are. Humble us in Your presence LORD. You are our great and awesome God. In Jesus Name, Amen.
