**Psalm 19:7, “The law of the LORD is perfect, refreshing the soul. The statutes of the LORD are trustworthy, making wise the simple.”**

The Hebrew word for *perfect* is **te mi mah** which means *sound, complete, upright and no blemish*. There is no doubt that the law of our LORD is without any fault of any kind, because that is Who God is. The LORD is perfect in every way and so His Word is also perfect in every way. This is such a critical fact for us to comprehend because it is a foundation for our faith.

I love the last part of this verse which says - making wise the simple. There is hope for me! I can be so foolish sometimes; thinking that I know so much, when in fact, I am so self-assured. I don't need more of me, I always need more of Him and His word in my life.
