Ps. 55:22, “Cast your cares on the LORD and He will sustain you; He will never let the righteous be shaken.”

The Hebrew word for *sustain* is **yechalkelecha** which means *to provide, endure, nourish or to bear you up*. What an awesome blessing we have in this verse. We can come to our loving Father and know that He will sustain us. **1 Pt. 5:7, “Cast all your anxiety on Him because He cares for you.** And again in **Ps. 91:11-12 For He will command His angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways; they will lift you up in their hands, so that you will not strike your foot against a stone.”** These are promises given to the righteous. You may be thinking, “Well I’m not very righteous; I am a sinner.” We all are sinners. What makes a person righteous is not the doing of good things, but instead being covered by the blood of the sinless Lamb of God, Jesus Christ! **2 Cor. 5:21, “God made Him Who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in Him we might become the righteousness of God.”** This was the reconciliation of Christ upon the cross. He took all the sin upon Himself so that He could pay our sin debt!

The Hebrew word for *shaken* is **movt** which means *to slip, fall, bring down or give away*. This passage reminds us of the faithfulness of God as He watches over His own and He will never let you fall. He will never let the righteous be shaken, slip, fall or give away. He is always there for you and He will never fail you! Hallelujah!

Dear LORD, You are our Sustainer and our Rock that we can cling to. You will always provide for us and watch over us. Help us to cast our cares on You because You care so much for us, In Jesus Name, Amen
