**Ps. 20:7, “Some trust in chariots and some in horses, but we trust in the name of the LORD our God.”**

Is there someone or something that you completely trust? Trust is a fragile thing. It can be broken so easily. This passage reminds us that there is one thing you can always trust; the name of the LORD our God.

Our God is not mostly trustworthy or fairly good at keeping His word. The Hebrew term here is nazkir which carries the connotation that we can boast in the fact that our LORD God will always be faithful and He will always come through for His children. He is held by His very character to a standard of perfection. There will never be a time that He falls short or lets us down.

The comparison here is stark because so many people trust in the powers of this world; wealth, power, prestige, popularity and glamour. They are so deceived into believing that if you have those “things” then you are invincible. Every one of them realizes that at some point, all of the things of this world will fail them. As soon as you trust your wealth, it can vanish. If you trust in your looks, things change quickly with age. Everything in this world will ultimately fade or fall apart; but not our God. He is the same yesterday, today and forever!

**Dear LORD, we praise You alone our LORD God. You are trustworthy. We know that our only hope is in You. Help us to keep our eyes fixed on You and not the things of this world that will surely fail and fade away. In Jesus Name, Amen**
