Ps. 29:10, “*The LORD sits enthroned over the flood; the LORD is enthroned as King forever.*” (NIV)

The Hebrew word for *enthroned* literally means *to inhabit, remain or abides*. There is stability in the fact that the LORD will always be on the throne.
