The Lord wants you to experience real and abundant life:

Luke 9:23 Then He said to them all: "Whoever wants to be My disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow Me." (NIV)

Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour. (NIV) Let's not let this be us. I am His and He is mine.
