The Lord wants you to experience real and abundant life:

Phil. 2:9-11 Therefore God exalted Him to the highest place and gave Him the name that is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue acknowledge that Jesus Christ is LORD, to the glory of God the Father. (NIV)

These next three verses from Paul's letter to the Philippians show us the purpose for Christ's coming to this earth. It is the climax of all of the work of Jesus. And this is the highest exaltation from every living being. There is absolutely no doubt, that when Jesus came into this world through the hand of God, He was the very hand of God. His name is salvation to the saved and damnation to the lost.

When we celebrate the birth of Christ to this world, we are also looking to the exaltation of Him to this world. He came with a purpose; to seek and to save those that are lost. He has done His part. He has given His very life for this cause. There is no greater gift you could give than to tell them the gospel. Let's make this season a season of salvation. Let's give the only gift that has eternal value. Let's lift up the name of Jesus and confess Him as LORD right now! JESUS, YOU ARE LORD!
