The Lord wants you to experience real and abundant life:

Isa. 9:6 For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. (NIV)

Now although this passage is a foreshadowing of the coming Messiah, Jesus, it is also a preview of His second coming as well. People will see what Isaiah was proclaiming when he said: *He will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.* This world will finally see what it could have been if we would have just followed the LORD all along. A new heaven and a new earth. All people recognizing the Jesus is King and Messiah. And ultimately, every knee will bow, and every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is LORD!
