The Lord wants you to experience real and abundant life:

Prov. 11:25 A generous person will prosper; whoever refreshes others will be refreshed. (NIV)

Maybe as you are shopping for something that might bring a smile to someone's face, also be shopping for an opportunity to bring an everlasting hope to their life. Here's an idea: As you wrap their present, maybe insert a note of personal testimony with a special word from God's Word. And do this in love and not condemnation. Remember, people don't care how much you know until they know how much you care!
