The Lord wants you to experience real and abundant life:

## **Eph. 2:8-9** For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith--and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God--not by works, so that no one can boast. (NIV)

Let me ask you a question today: how hard did you have to work to obtain salvation? I know you know the answer to this, and yet so many people are bound to this religious philosophy of trying to work their way into God's grace. Let me just set the record straight. You cannot be good enough to get to heaven on your own because 'good enough' won't cut it. It takes perfection. It takes never sinning.
