The Lord wants you to experience real and abundant life:

Rom. 12:2 Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is--His good, pleasing and perfect will. (NIV)

What one generation thought and followed, can be switched for something totally opposite by the next generation. The thoughts, ideals and philosophies of some can be completely ignored by others. We must cling to the only non-changing thing in this world: the LORD God Himself. He is the same yesterday, today and forever. We are to test every thought and principle by what the scripture teaches us. His Word is the litmus paper that lets us know if principles and philosophies can be embraced or should be rejected. We must not be a group of lemmings that would follow the crowd, no matter the peril that lies ahead. Instead we must be transformed into spiritual warriors that will stand (even if it is alone) for what is right. We will be able, with the Holy Spirit's help, to test and approve what God's will is.
