The Lord wants you to experience real and abundant life:

**Ps. 33:4 *For the word of the LORD is right and true; He is faithful in all He does.* (NIV)**

The Psalmist begins this passage with a declaration of the God's purity. We've all heard commercials about products that were 99.9% effective. I always wondered what about that 1%. Would I be the unfortunate one that this product didn't kill the one bacterium that was carrying a terrible disease. You see, in this world, there is really nothing perfect or completely trustworthy.
