The Lord wants you to experience real and abundant life:

## John 7:38 "Whoever believes in Me, as Scripture has said, rivers of living water will flow from within them." (NIV)

Real and abundant life is not just for us to experience. It has a purpose. We will be looking as some of the reasons that the LORD has given us this kind of life. In this quote by Jesus, we are made aware that this life is not just so that we can experience it, but more importantly it is so that we can share it with others.
