The Lord wants you to live in His liberty and freedom.

Rom. 6:17-18 *But thanks be to God that, though you used to be slaves to sin, you have come to obey from your heart the pattern of teaching that has now claimed your allegiance. You have been set free from sin and have become slaves to righteousness. (NIV)*

Yesterday, we looked at the fact that we all have choices to make. Paul reminds those that choose wisely, to remember what it was like to be a slave to your own sins and desires. But now, because of obedience, you have been set free from the sin that so easily entangles, and have been enlisted in the Father's plan for you. His plan is to walk in righteousness and love. Now walking in righteousness simply means walking and abiding in His will and His way.

What a wonderful thought to meditate on today. We have been set free from sin! It has no hold on those who are His children. The only way it can affect us is if we choose to let it. Like we looked at yesterday, we all have choices every day, all day long. What will you choose today? Will you be a slave to sin or a slave of righteousness. We can choose to obey or disobey. Each choice has either a blessing or a consequence. **Rom. 8:28** *And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love Him, who have been called according to His purpose. (NIV)*
