## God proves His love to you by providing **His protection** to you. **1 Cor. 13:7**, *"It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres."*

The Greek word for **protect** is *stegei* which means to bear you up through difficulties, trials, and temptations. And that's exactly what God's love can do for you. It is the love of God that is there for you when you face the struggles of this life. He is the rock on which you can lean and the strength to make it through. The further connotation is that He not only lifts you up, but you are protected from those things or people that are trying to attack you. You are out of harm's way so to speak. And God is faithful; He will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, He will provide a way out so that you can endure it.*"
