God proves His love to you by **His comforting love**. **2 Cor. 1:3-4** *Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of compassion and the God of <u>all comfort</u>, Who <u>comforts</u> us in all our troubles, so that we can <u>comfort</u> those in any trouble with the <u>comfort</u> we ourselves receive from God.*
