Because God loves you, He Provides- Part 196

Did you know that God loves you more than anyone else could ever love you?

God proves His love to you by **His light giving love. John 1:9-10, “*The true Light, which gives Light to everyone, was coming into the world. He was in the world, yet the world did not know Him.*”**

The Greek word for *true light* is **alethinon phos** which means *the only true and real source of light or radiance*. When Jesus came into this world, there was a bright light shining from above. Some very wise men chose to follow that light and they found the Savior. The first recorded words of God had to do with light. Jesus taught that as believers, we are the light of the world and that we should let our light so shine that others can see. **Mt. 4:16** speaks of Jesus by stating: ***“the people living in darkness have seen a great light; on those living in the land of the shadow of death a light has dawned.”***
