## Because God loves you, He Provides- Part 197

Did you know that God loves you more than anyone else could ever love you? God proves His love to you by **His indescribable love**. 2 Cor. 9:15, "*Thanks be to God for His indescribable gift*."

The Greek word for *indescribable* is **anekdiegeto** which means *inexpressible, incomparable, or that cannot be thoroughly related.* As Paul was writing the church in Corinth, he was encouraging them to give all thanks to God. The reason for the thanks is His indescribable gift of Jesus Christ; a gift of a personal relationship with Him by knowing Him personally.

A few years ago, I was at a conference with my pastor and we got to hear Tim LaHaye speak. Afterwards, because my pastor knew Tim, we got to go out to eat and I just sat and listened to Tim share his incredible love for God and the Word of God. I know that I would not have ever had an opportunity to meet Dr. LaHaye on my own, but my friend and pastor introduced me to him. I will always remember that night and the joy of hearing many great truths of God.

In a similar way, Paul was also exhorting the church at Corinth to share this incredible love of God with those that they knew or came in contact with. The gift of Jesus has great value because as **Isa. 9:6** says: "*He will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, the Everlasting Father and the Prince of Peace.*"
