Compassionate Love - Part 2

Psalm 103:8-18 The Lord is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, abounding in love. He will not always accuse, nor will he harbor His anger forever; He does not treat us as our sins deserve or repay us according to our iniquities. For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is His love for those who fear Him; as far as the east is from the west, so far has He removed our transgressions from us. As a father has compassion on his children, so the Lord has compassion on those who fear Him; for He knows how we are formed, He remembers that we are dust. The life of mortals is like grass, they flourish like a flower of the field; the wind blows over it and it is gone, and its place remembers it no more. There is no place that we could ever go where God would say, "you've crossed the line and I don't love you anymore." What an amazing, awesome, compassionate Father we have who loves us and loves us and loves us.....as Buzz Light-year would say: To infinity and beyond! He never gives up on us. He never treats us like what we deserve. He never blows up and walks out on us. He never says, "it's over." He just loves. Why? Not get this; Love is not something God does, but Who He is! His compassions, they fail not; Great is Thy Faithfulness... Oh Compassionate Father, I thank You that Your love will never end because You will never end.
