It is God's gift to all who will call upon the name of the Lord. And, as a wise old Sunday School teacher once told her children, love is spelled like this: J-E-S-U-S. The one who conquered death and the grave, did it through the power of love. Let this love, this conquering love, flow through you to overcome the barriers, the walls that have been erected by hate, discord, disbelief, and selfishness. He will use us to overcome all of these things.

Dear Lord, thank You for Your conquering love. Nothing can stand against it. I praise You Father that You have poured out Your love on those who have called upon You. Use everyone of us to share Your magnificent love to this world in need; to our friends, our neighbors, our co-workers, our relatives, to the outcast. In Jesus Name, Amen
