The Names of Love - Part 11 - Jehovah Sabaoth

1 Sam. 1:3, "Year after year this man went up from his town to worship and sacrifice to the Lord Almighty at Shiloh, where Hophni and Phinehas, the two sons of Eli, were priests of the LORD."

The Name of God in this passage is Jehovah Sabaoth; The Lord of Hosts.

When you think of this name, it reminds us all that He is not just my Lord, He is Lord of all; all of creation bows in honor of Who He is, Jehovah Sabaoth. In the same manner, Jesus came as the visible image of the invisible God and Philippians 2:9-11 exclaims: "Therefore God exalted Him to the highest place and gave Him the name that is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is LORD, to the glory of God the Father."

This is also the name that David used when confronting Goliath in 1 Sam. 17:45-46 "You come to me with sword and spear and javelin; but I come to you in the name of the LORD of hosts, the God of the armies of Israel, Whom you have defied. This very day the LORD will deliver you into my hand."

Suffice it to say, that all of creation realizes that there is one LORD, Jehovah Sabaoth. Isa. 55 states that the mountains and the hills will burst forth into song before you and all the trees of the field will clap their hands. And Jesus tells the people that even the rocks will cry out.

This is such a critical understanding to realize that God is not just a God, He is THE GOD. He is LORD of all. The question for everyone in this life is will you make Him your LORD? He already is LORD, but will you recognize that very fact.

Dear Jehovah Sabaoth, I praise You because You are LORD of all. There is nothing outside of Your authority. You will continue to reign forever and forever more. Help me to live in the moment of this fact; that You and You alone are Jehovah Sabaoth. In Jesus Name, Amen
