Because God loves you, He Provides- Part 145

Did you know that God loves you more than anyone else could ever love you?

God proves His love to you by **His God-breathed love. 2 Tim. 3:16** “**All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness.**”

The Greek term for *God-breathed* is *theopneustos* which means *spoken by the inspiration of God*. What is it that inspires you most? The definition of inspiration is being stimulated to do or feel something, and to act upon it. God’s word is there to inspire us to not only know what we ought to do, but also to put it into action. All of Scripture is there to teach us, to correct us and even rebuke us when we are wrong. But all of that is for naught unless we allow it to make changes deep within our core; inside our soul and will. **James 4:17** states, “***If anyone, then, knows the good they ought to do and doesn’t do it, it is sin for them.***”

God loves us so much that He has breathed His Holy Spirit into the word of God so that it can inspire us, teach us, and direct us as we should go. The author of **Hebrews 4:12** reminds us: “***For the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.***” And again in **James 2:22**, we read, “***Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says.***” Our heart’s desire should be to be inspired by God’s word and then put it into practice as we walk in Him.
