Because God loves you, He Provides- Part 102

Did you know that God loves you more than anyone else could ever love you?

God proves His love to you by His guiding love. **Isa. 58:11** *“The Lord will guide you always; He will satisfy your needs in a sun-scorched land and will strengthen your frame. You will be like a well-watered garden, like a spring whose waters never fail.”*

The Hebrew word for guide is venachacha which means to lead by stationing oneself in front of someone else. What an amazing thought this is if you would meditate upon it. God Himself is walking ahead of you to guide you where He wants you to go. He knows the best way for you and He beckons you to follow in His path. He does this specifically by His Word. Scripture is our guide as Jesus is the Word of God. God has not left us alone.
