Because God loves you, He Provides- Part 108

God proves His love to you by His blessing love. **Psalm 5:12** *“For it is You who blesses the righteous man, O Lord, You surround him with favor as with a shield.”*

The Hebrew word for blesses is *tevarech* which means to abundantly and greatly bless.
