## 2 Tim. 2:13 If we are faithless, He remains faithful; He cannot deny Himself. (NKJV)

Sometimes, the best thing we can do is just say thank you! I mean, when you think about it, how else can we say thanks for God's faithfulness? Paul is telling Timothy that there are so many times that we are faithless. We say we believe, but don't walk in faith. We say we believe, but don't share it with others. We say we believe, but act like nothing has changed. What a fickle lot we are. We say one thing and then do another. We are about as faithless as anyone could be. But, then there is our LORD, the true and faithful One. Paul says, the LORD remains faithful. Why? Because that is Who God is. It is His character, His nature. It cannot be changed because if it was, He would cease to be God Himself.

The Greek word for *cannot deny* is **arnesasthai** which means *not possible or able with any amount of might*. Our Faithful Father could never, ever become unfaithful because it would deny Who He is. He is faithful, always and forever.

This should bring us great comfort and stability, knowing that He will always be faithful. He was, is and always will be. And because of that, we can walk in confidence, knowing that our LORD is ever watching over His children. He is always providing for us. He is shedding His light upon our path. He is encouraging us as a Father encourages his son. He is teaching us and directing us in the way that we should go. He is a friend that sticks closer than a brother. He will never abandon us. He will always fight for us. He will always listen to our cries.

Dear LORD, there is no One like You. You are faithful beyond all comprehension. You will always be faithful. We can rely on You because You cannot deny Who You are. Thank You LORD. In Jesus Name, Amen
