Our God Is LORD

Rev. 1:8 *“I AM the Alpha and the Omega, the beginning and the ending, says the LORD, Who is, and Who was, and Who is to come, the Almighty.”*

The Greek word for *Almighty* is **pantokrator** which means *unrestricted power exercising absolute dominion*. As humans, we tend to think only in the arena of time. It’s all we’ve ever known. Our brains function on the process of time; there is a beginning and an end. These are parameters that the LORD Almighty created. **Ps. 118:24** *This is the day that the LORD has made; I will rejoice and be glad in it.*

We must be thankful for the time that God has given us. The Hebrew term **bara** is the ability to bring forth. This scripture tells us that it is **bara ex nihilo** - created out of nothing.
