Our God Is Lord

Ps. 127:3-5 Children are a heritage from the LORD, offspring a reward from Him. Like arrows in the hands of a warrior are children born in one's youth. Blessed is the man whose quiver is full of them. They will not be put to shame when they contend with their opponents in court. (NIV)

As we saw yesterday, this psalm is attributed to King Solomon. He gives an important statement here for us all; the incredible importance of children. The Hebrew term for heritage is nachalat which means an inheritance, a gift or a treasure of great value.

It seems in our present world that children have somehow lost value in the eyes of many. Seemingly, they have become a burden instead of a treasure. They are treated as though they are a hardship, a strain; that they are in the way or something extra we must deal with. What a dreadful perspective that our society has embraced.
