## Because God loves you, He Provides- Part 171

Did you know that God loves you more than anyone else could ever love you?

God proves His love to you by **His wonders**. **Ps. 9:1**, "I will give thanks to the LORD with all my heart; I will tell of all Your wonders."

The Hebrew word for *wonders* is **nif le ov tei cha** which means *marvelous*, *what seems hard*, *wondrous*, *or miraculous*.
