Because God loves you, He Provides- Part 125

Did you know that God loves you more than anyone else could ever love you?

God proves His love to you by **His judging love**. Rev. 19:1-2, 6 *“After these things I heard something like a loud voice of a great multitude in heaven, saying, “Hallelujah! Salvation and glory and power belong to our God; because His judgments are true and righteous; for He has judged the great harlot who was corrupting the earth with her immorality, and He has avenged the blood of His bond-servants on her.” Then I heard what seemed to be the voice of a great multitude, like the roar of many waters and like the sound of mighty peals of thunder, crying out Hallelujah! For the LORD our God, the Almighty reigns!”*

The Greek word for judge is *kriseis* which means *to bring down a final decision*. I grew up in an era when TV shows were much different than now. Father knew best, the good guy always won, and even horses could talk. In today's world, all boundaries are lost and what used to be unthinkable is now paraded before our eyes as normal. But there was a time when justice meant something. Perry Mason could always sniff out the guilty. Columbo always trapped the criminal in their own traps. There will again be a time when justice reigns supreme. He will judge those who have no care for Him and turned to their own ways. He will judge the ones who have purposely led others astray. He will judge. And when He does, no one will be able to stand against His glory and power. As the song says:
